# PREPARATORY ACADEMY DRESS CODE

#### **Dress and Grooming**

While fashions change, the reason for being at the Academy does not. Students are in the Academy to learn. Any fashion (dress, accessory, or hairstyle) that disrupts the educational processor presents a safety risk will not be permitted. Personal expression is permitted within these general guidelines. Students are required to wear the Academy uniform every day. The Academy colors are khaki or black for bottoms and green, black or white for the tops. **Students can not wear neon colors or any other color NOT part of the Marion Preparatory academy approved color schemes. The uniform guidelines are as follows:** 

Bottoms: Solid Khaki or Black Tops: Solid Dark Green, Black or White

Pants\* Polo Shirts

Shorts\* Collard Button-down shirt

Jumpers\* Turtlenecks

Skorts/Skirts\* Cardigans, sweaters, vests,

Crewneck sweatshirts

**Shoes:** Tennis shoes (solid w/no more than 1 other color) Winter boots w/ approved color scheme during Winter months. ALL shoes must be enclosed. **NO** flip flops, open crocs, ballet-type, sandals, shoes w/ wheels.

#### Accessories:

Belts- Black or Brown (Not Required)

Tights/leggings (under skirts, skorts and jumpers) Solid school colors

- \*All shorts, skirts/skorts, jumpers must be NO less than 1 inch above the knee. NO tattered, torn or oversize acceptable. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- \*PROHIBITED: hoodies, hoodie jackets, sweatpants, outerwear (worn in class), Items w/ sequins, glitter or jewels, no logos or designs other than Marion Prep. No shorts from December-February. Leggings can **ONLY** to be worn under skirts/jumpers and are not acceptable attire alone.
